

Businesses Celebrate 10 years of Weaving a Resilient Community

Below is a summary of SBF Foundation's strategic initiatives.

A solid foundation, a resilient Singapore

People are at the heart of businesses. The SBF Foundation journeys with businesses who are passionate to serve vulnerable communities through collective giving towards the following purpose-driven initiatives:

Caring From Within - the Industry-led Compassion Fund, initiated at the height of the pandemic in 2020, is a collective support with trade associations (TACs) to help employees in need due to unforeseen hardships. Since 2020, the business community raised \$2.2m to set up 8 Industry-led Funds which benefitted more than 235 employees to date;

Dignity Through Employment - the Employability Fund supports businesses to empower and employ vulnerable jobseekers including people who are homeless, vulnerable women, and persons with mental health conditions. Businesses also participate in Empower Circles for best practice sharing on progressive hiring practices. In the last 3 years, we have engaged with more than 200 new employers, and supported 800 vulnerable jobseekers;

Empowering Disadvantaged Youths - "Youth Connections" encourages business leaders to share their experiences to inspire youths especially those from disadvantaged backgrounds, to be resilient in overcoming adversities. Following a successful pilot last year, this program will be expanded to benefit our future leaders;


Augmenting Migrant Wellbeing - MigrantWell is a donor-initiated project to care for the health and wellbeing of migrant workers, with seed funding from the estates of Khoo Teck Puat and Ng Teng Fong. Since February 2022, the medical centre in Penjuru has served over 28,500 migrant workers in healthcare and care gap services including dental care, mental health and physiotherapy/ rehabilitation;

new Corporate Purpose Fund – In our next lap, we aim to help enable businesses especially SMEs to embark on and strengthen their ESG efforts particularly to create "Social Impact" aligned with their corporate purpose.
